Neighbourhood Plan

We held our first public meeting to consult on the Neighbourhood Plan on 23rd July 2012 and at last some four years later we are beginning to see the light at the end of the tunnel!

At the first public meeting and subsequent meetings we consulted with residents of the Parish to establish what facilities and future development the Parish wanted written into the plan. The plan has been produced predicated on these requirements whilst adhering to Local and National Planning regulations.

Currently the Neighbourhood Plan working party are working with CWAC to appoint an inspector to analyse the plan, subsequent to his report we will consider his findings in conjunction with CWAC and hopefully we will then be able to organise the referendum within the Parish later this summer to ratify the Neighbourhood Plan.

I should like to thank all those on the Neighbourhood Plan Working Group for the hours of work they have put in to achieve the progress so far.
